- Blue Ridge and PP&L account due dates have been synced up to cut down on weekly checks needed for our multiple accounts.
- Regarding the Capital Reserve Study, we've spoken with 3 companies. 1 advised they are booked up but we can reach out again in 6 months. 1 gave an estimate of \$10,649. The 3<sup>rd</sup> gave an estimate between \$5700-\$7000. Another local community manager gave this company a glowing recommendation.
