Speed Limit is 10MPH throughout Trails End. Security monitors speed with radar. Thank you for your cooperation.

Burn Ban: has been lifted. Please use the utmost caution in burning. **Reminder: Campfires must be enclosed and have a charged hose nearby and the fire must be attended at all times. Citations will be issued. Please check for burn ban updates.**

Golf Carts: Remember to register at the Association Office & get a 2020 registration sticker. Appointments are required. Office phone number is (570) 296-8542. Please bring proof of insurance with you. Each full dues paying lot is allowed one golf cart. Registration is \$50. Golf Carts are to remain on the roads; please do not drive on the walking trails or paths. **Driving and/or parking a golf cart on the grass in front of the clubhouse is prohibited.** Thank you!

Barcode Decals: Please come prepared with your Photo ID, current vehicle registration and insurance; barcodes cannot be affixed during inclement weather. Appointments required. Please call the office at (570) 296-8542 to make your appointment.

Pools: Will be open until closed for season. Hours 11am-4pm Monday thru Friday, and 11am-7pm Saturday and Sunday. All hours are weather and staffing permitting. Reminder: All children must wear “swimmy diapers” to swim in the pool! Thank you! CDC guidelines are being monitored.

Clubhouse: Closed until further notice.

Fitness Center: Closed until further notice.

Game Room: Closed for the season. Will be open Columbus Day Weekend.

Ice: Sold in the Game Room (when opened) \$2 per bag.

Concession: Open for take-out only:

9/10 9am-5pm, 9/11 9am-8pm, 9/12 9am-8pm, 9/13 9am-5pm, 9/14-17 closed, 9/18 1pm-8pm, 9/19 1pm-3pm, 9/20 1pm-3pm, 9/21-23 closed. To order online go to trailsend.org (under the concession tab) to place your order or you can call Concession directly at (570) 296-7938.

BAR: Outside Bar closed until Columbus Day Weekend. Will be open Sat. & Sun. that weekend in front of the Clubhouse starting at 7pm. Inside Bar is closed. Social distancing enforced along with mask requirement when approaching the bar.

Library: Closed until further notice.

Dump Area: 8:30am-3:30pm daily. (Closed during inclement weather.)

Security Reminders:

- **Guest Restrictions** – Only deeded property owners (husband, wife, sons & daughters) currently allowed. This is until further notice and will be strictly enforced.
- **Boats** - Property Owners must register their boat with security. Please call Security at (570) 296-8549 to make an appointment. If already registered, you may pick up your registration card at the gatehouse.

Reminders:

- **Pin Numbers** – must be used when registering a guest/contractor at the gatehouse. If you have misplaced your pin number please contact the office at (570) 296-8542 and it will be mailed to you. To register guests/contractors contact Security at (570) 296-8549.
- **911 Address** - As per Shohola Twp. Ordinance 67 all lots must have their 911 address posted. The sign must be hung no lower than 4 feet nor higher than 8ft; it must have the address numbers in block style no less than 3 inches high and be on reflective material; the sign should be posted next to the driveway no further than 10ft from the road. This 911 sign is extremely important for any emergency vehicles that may need to locate your lot. If you do not know your 911 address, please contact the association office.
- **Propane Tanks**- Tanks must be date stamped within ten years. Please check your tanks and contact your gas provider if they are outdated. If the outdated tanks belong to you, they may be disposed of at our dump during normal dump hours. The fee is \$5.00 per tank (up to 100lbs.), payable at the Association Office. Once paid, take your receipt and your tank(s) to the dump for disposal. All tanks must have the receipt number written on them. PA Regulations on Propane Tanks are available at the office.
- **PA State Law** – requires those 12 yrs. old and younger to wear bicycle helmets while riding bicycles. For your child’s safety please abide by this state law.
- **Pets** – Must be kept on a leash at all times. Pets are not permitted in common areas – the playground, pool areas, clubhouse & game room. You must clean up after your pet! Pets must be attended at all times.
- **Permits** – Must be obtained from Trails End and Shohola Township for new trailers, sheds, & decks. Permits must also be obtained from the office (at no cost) for removal of trees over 3 inches in diameter, block parties, and fences. Please call the Trails End office to make an appointment (570) 296-8542.
- **Sports Complex** - closes at 11pm Sunday through Thursday and at midnight on Friday & Saturday.
- **2020 Dues** – All dues were **due in the office by August 31, 2020**. If you have a balance due please call the office to make arrangements or pay online at trailsend.org, click on ‘make a payment’. If paying in person please call the office to make an appointment (570) 296-8542.

- **Address changes** - It is the responsibility of the property owner to notify the office of a change of address or phone number. If there has been any change of ownership, a copy of the deed reflecting the change in ownership must be given before any changes will be made.
- **Trespassing** – Anyone caught trespassing on association owned real estate, including green areas and common properties (common properties after operating hours) owned by the association will be fined \$300.00 for each occurrence.
- **Plexiglas** – Plexiglas/plastic window coverings must be removed from Memorial Day to Labor Day. Plexiglas/plastic can be placed over the windows in the summer season during inclement weather only.
- **AVOID feeding or leaving food for wild animals, stray dogs or cats, it is prohibited. Fines will be imposed for all violators. There has been numerous bear sightings in Trails End recently. Please make sure not to leave food and garbage around and to stay away from them. Call Security for assistance if you have a problem with bears.**
