<u>Sewer - Robert Personette</u>

- Five-year plan, Clint confirmed we have spare pumps for sewer plant.
- We need to look into getting a hot standby computer in event of current system failure.
- 'Factory Talk' is the system we currently use to run the switches and pumps; these are able to be monitored from home and our operator can receive alarms at home. The company who installed it before is no longer available and we will need to find a way to get it again on a new computer.
- Clint suggested that we need a designated 'Clean Water Operator' due to the rising standards of the EPA.
- Clean Water Act Requires proof of no lead pipes but will not take 'data' as a means to prove it.
- PFAS testing will cost \$2,700.00 per quarter.

Maintenance – Thomas Miller, Brian Fitzpatrick

- Maintenance has hired new employees and will continuing hiring.
- Landscaping company was contacted to add flowers, replace a dead tree and to clean up the front of the clubhouse.
- Tents in front of clubhouse will be put up by Memorial Day.
- Starting April 20th dump will be open daily for leaves and Saturdays and Sundays for containers.
- Need to replace two stand-up freezers in concession & kitchen. Both are old and parts are no longer available. Property Manager to have maintenance check Home Depot & Lowes to find the best prices and value.

- Currently there are 72 open Land Use violations
- 25 first letters were sent out since March's meeting
