- PO from lot #3212 asked about the webcams being on the website as previously discussed?

 - Chris/Mike- possibility for security at basketball courts? Hours at the courts could be the potential issue.
 - Patrol from 10 until closing?- budgetary concerns- but may solve issues

- Courts have been worse this year than previous years about noise complaintshowever, the sports complex closes at the same time quiet hours are in effect.
- \circ $\;$ Family campsite- we are essentially doing what's best for all property owners.
- PO lot #4540- didn't receive deed- asked about working on property but sees that he needs the deed before starting any work?
 - Rich- presumes there is no deed from tax claim bureaus- the PO needs to have it approved by the court which means they don't own it yet- TEPOA needs to follow all legalities so there is no permission to work on the lot until it is solely in the new property owner's name.
 - Alternative Action: Write letter to recent property owner and state the new property owner will be considering the property to be abandoned by a specific date so as to have a certified letter of abandonment in order to begin work on the property until the deed is finalized.
